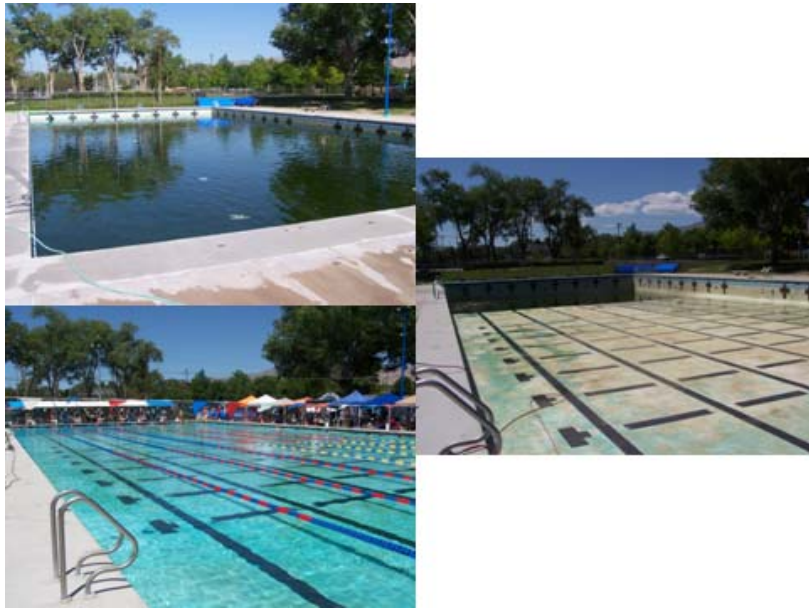

## Adopt-A-Pool Schedule

**Tuesday May 28<sup>th</sup>** - Duties: Pressure washing and clean out of pools, painting. As a large pump drains the pool the walls of the pool must be pressure washed to minimize staining the pool surface. 10am to 2:30pm.

**Wednesday May 29<sup>th</sup>** - Duties: Finishing wash-down of pools and clean-out of surge tank, painting. Tile repair and cleaning around the rim of the pool and portions of the pool surface. 7:30am to 2:30pm.

**Thursday May 30<sup>th</sup>** - Assist with tile repairs, fill pool, painting. 7:30am to 2:30pm.

**Friday May 31<sup>st</sup>** – Assist with pump and solar system start-up, touch up painting. 7:30am to 2:30pm.

### **Saturday June 1<sup>st</sup> Adopt-A-Pool day 10am to 1pm**

Remove weeds and rake planter beds, weed removal in playground adjacent to pool, planting for pool beds, sweep entrance and parking lot, hose and squeegee bath house/pool deck, clean windows, cleaning out gutter drains, installing wind screens on fence, painting.

**Trainer Pool: Tuesday June 4<sup>th</sup> – Thursday June 6<sup>th</sup>**. The City of Reno will need volunteers to help with cleaning, painting, repairing expansion joints, assistance with building preparation and pump start up. (7:30am to 2:30pm)
